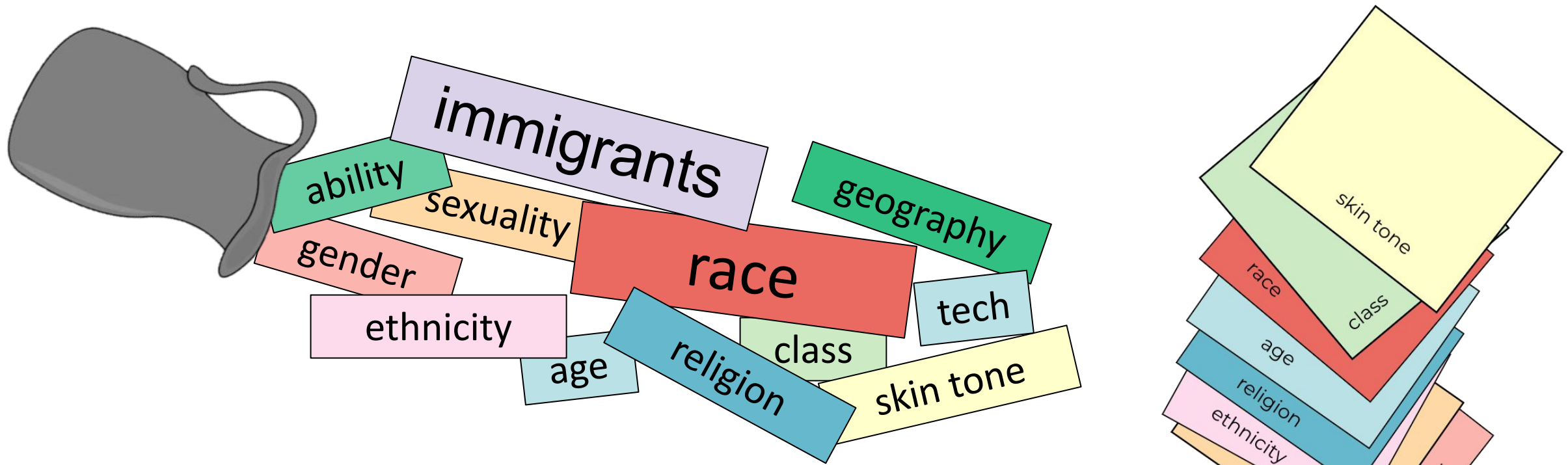

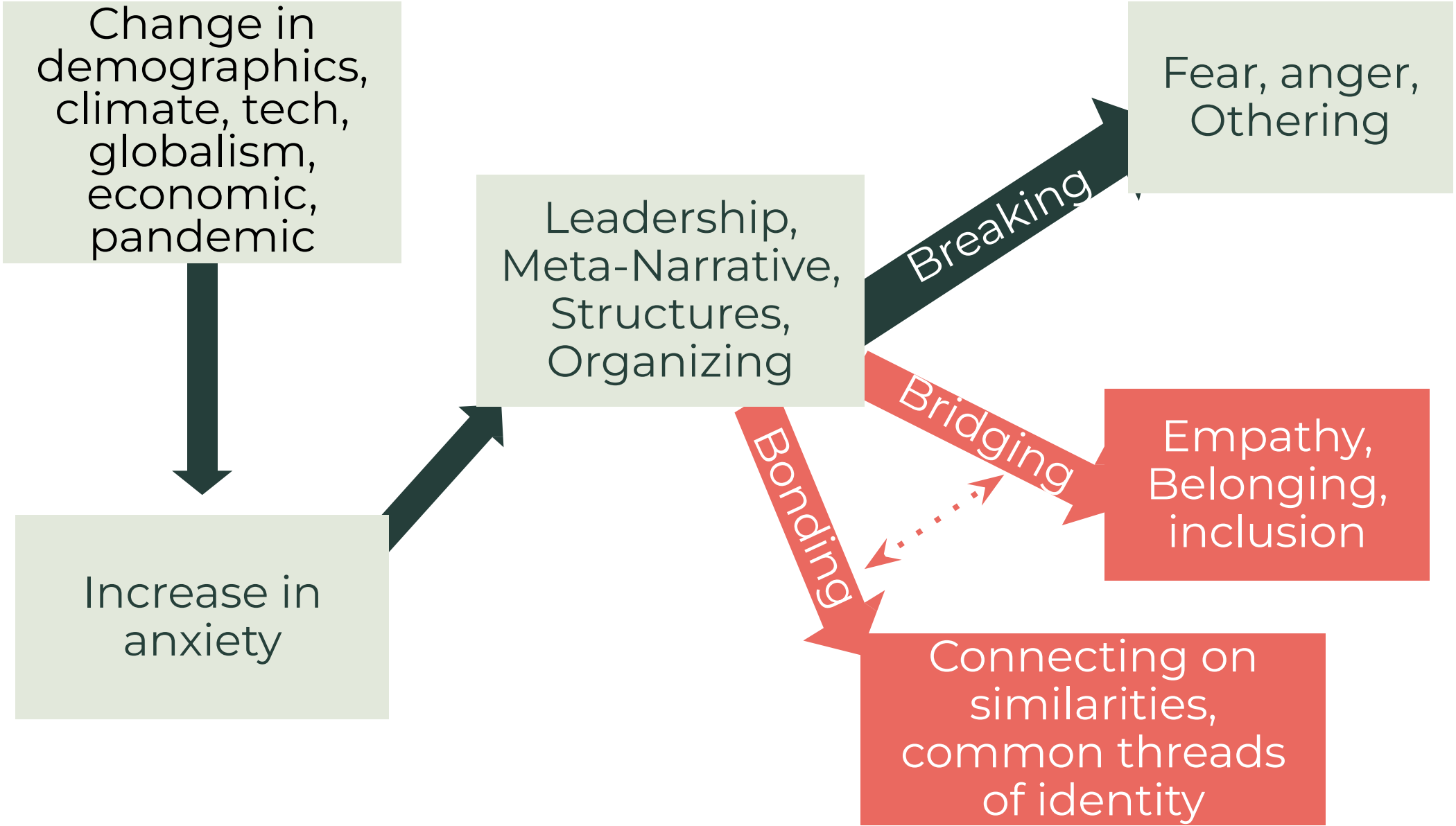

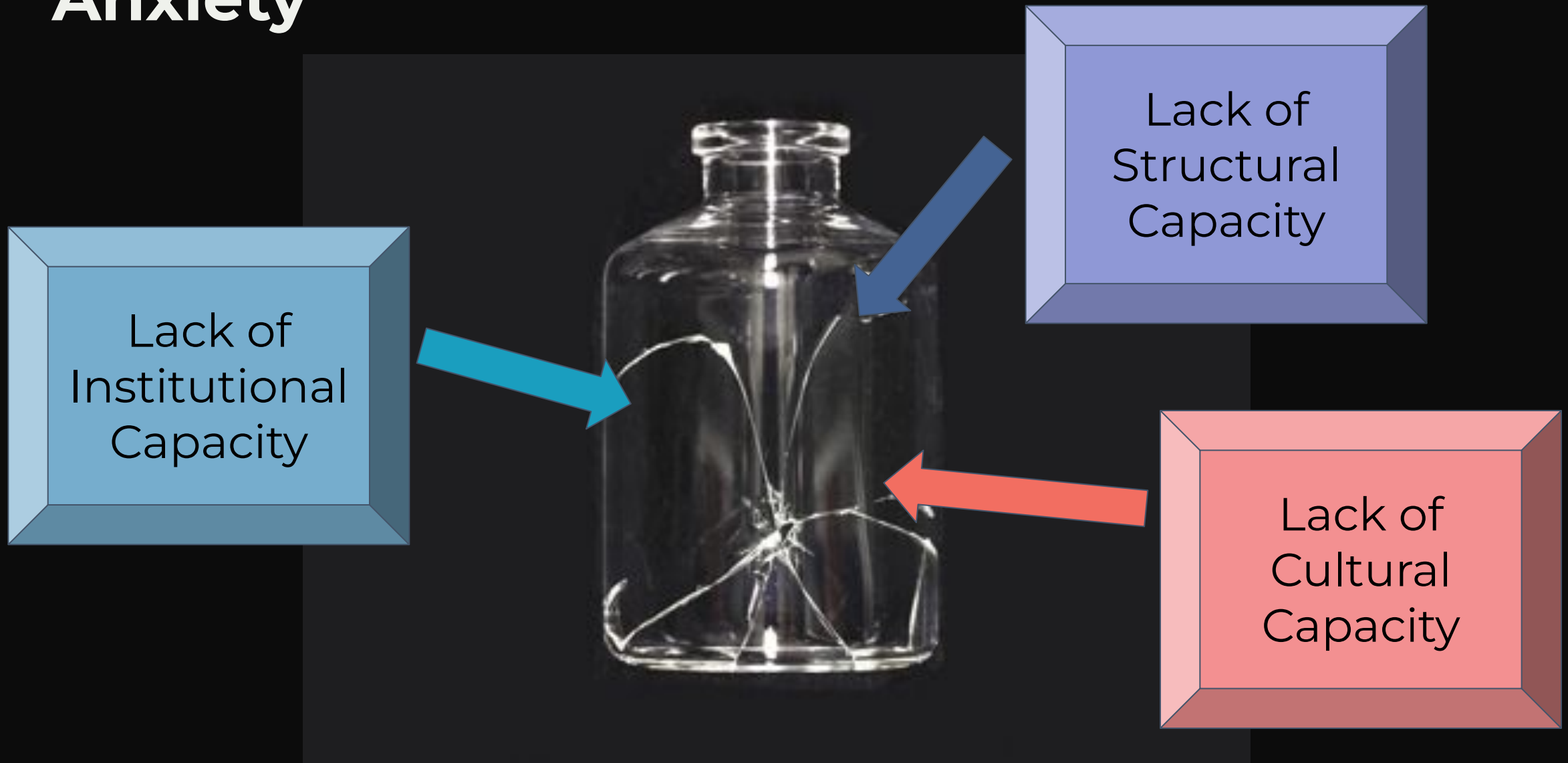


Othering is a generalized set of common processes that engender marginality and group-based inequality across any of the full range of human differences.

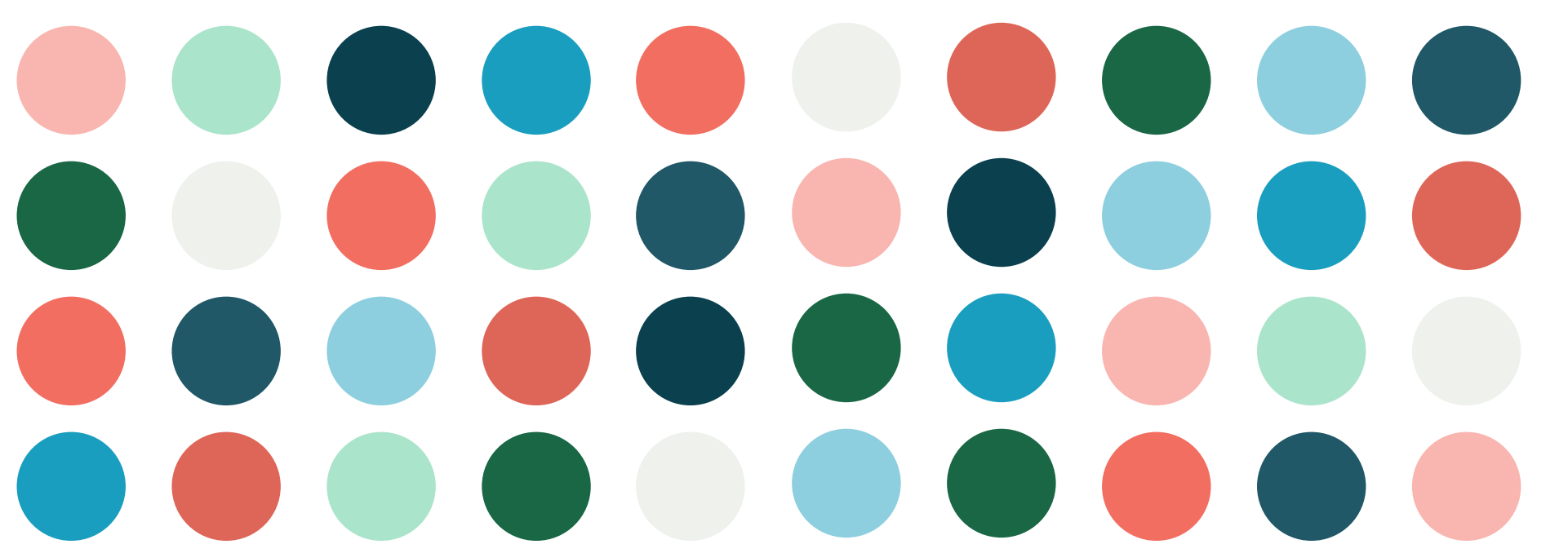


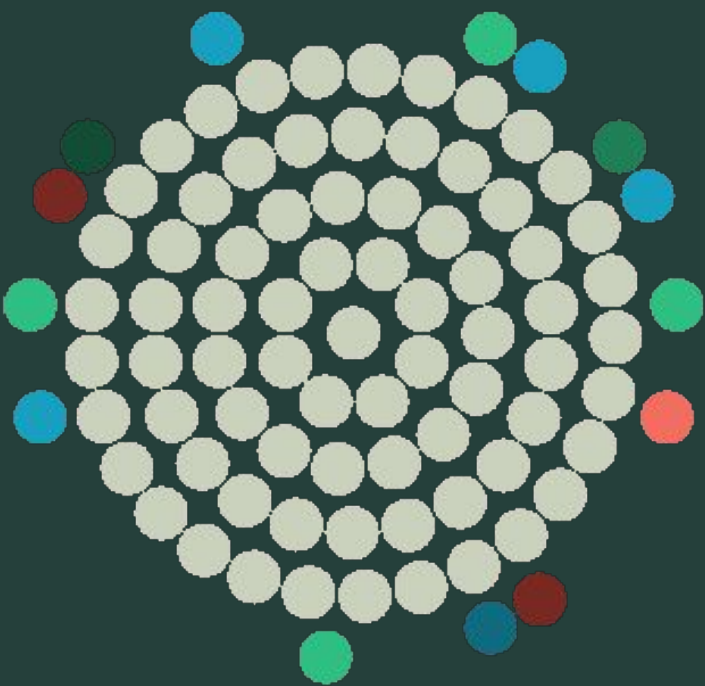
The opposite of Othering is not “saming.”



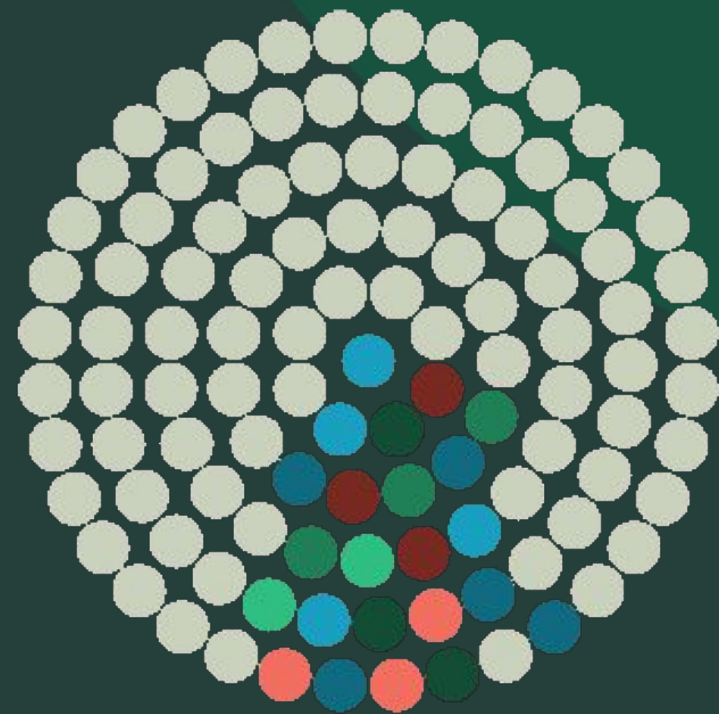

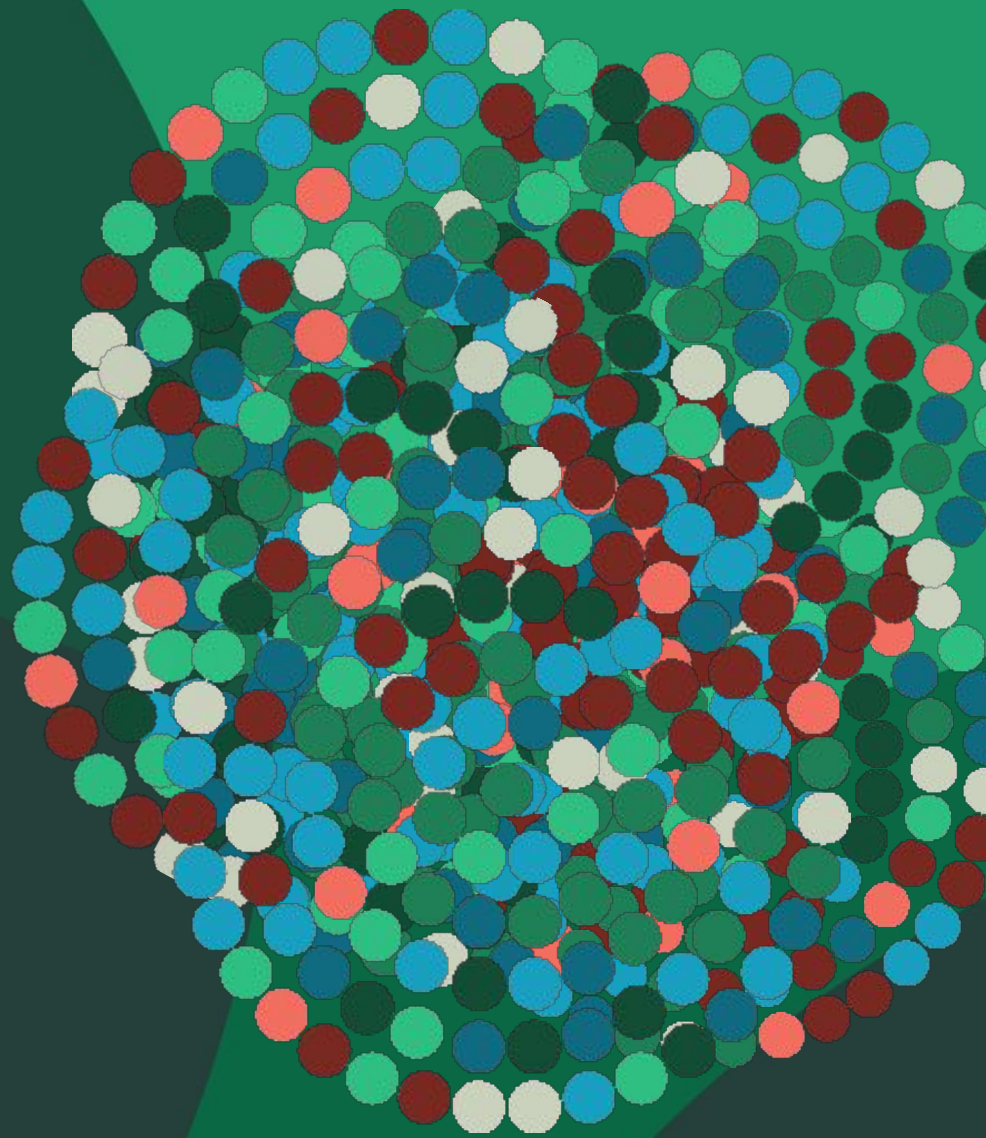

Bridging is a precondition for belonging.

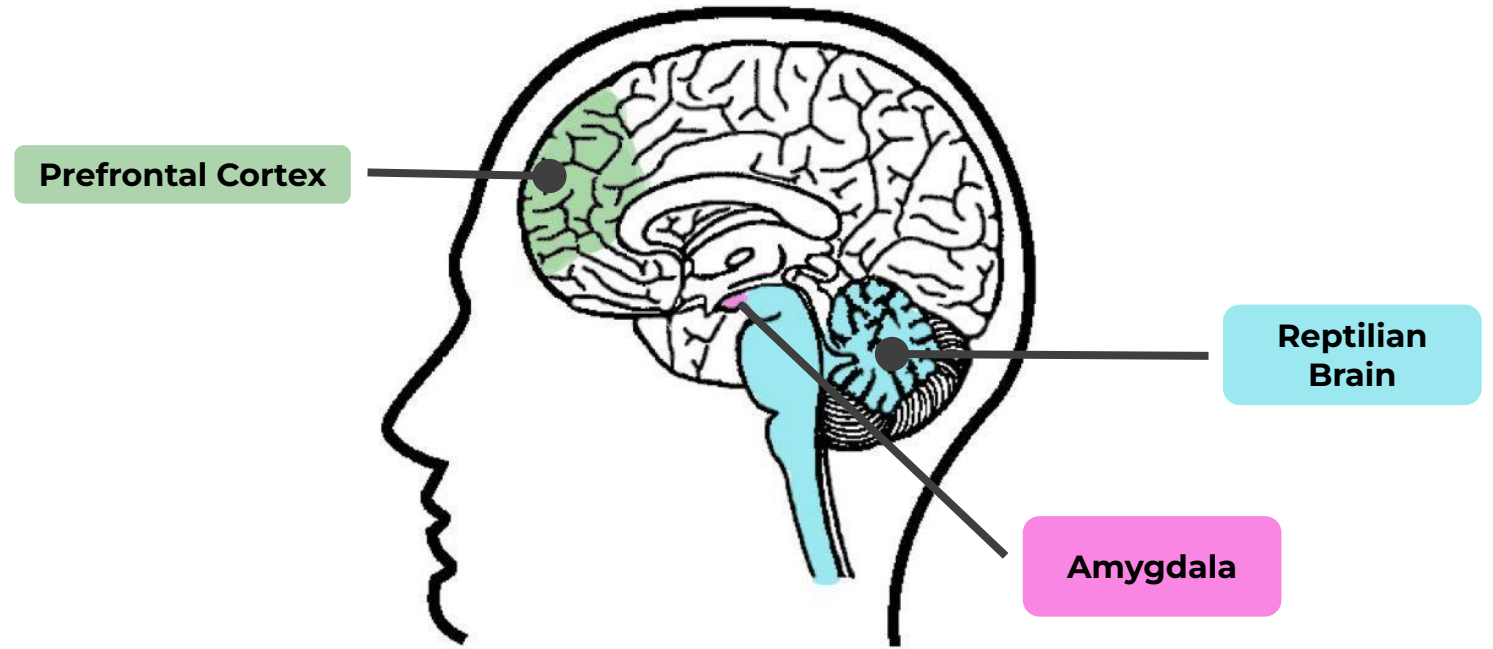
Stories and Narratives

Narratives of Othering and Belonging



Breaking: When a group turns inwards and explicitly pushes away from other groups who are seen as dangerous or a threat.



Bonding: Connecting to people like you in some important way



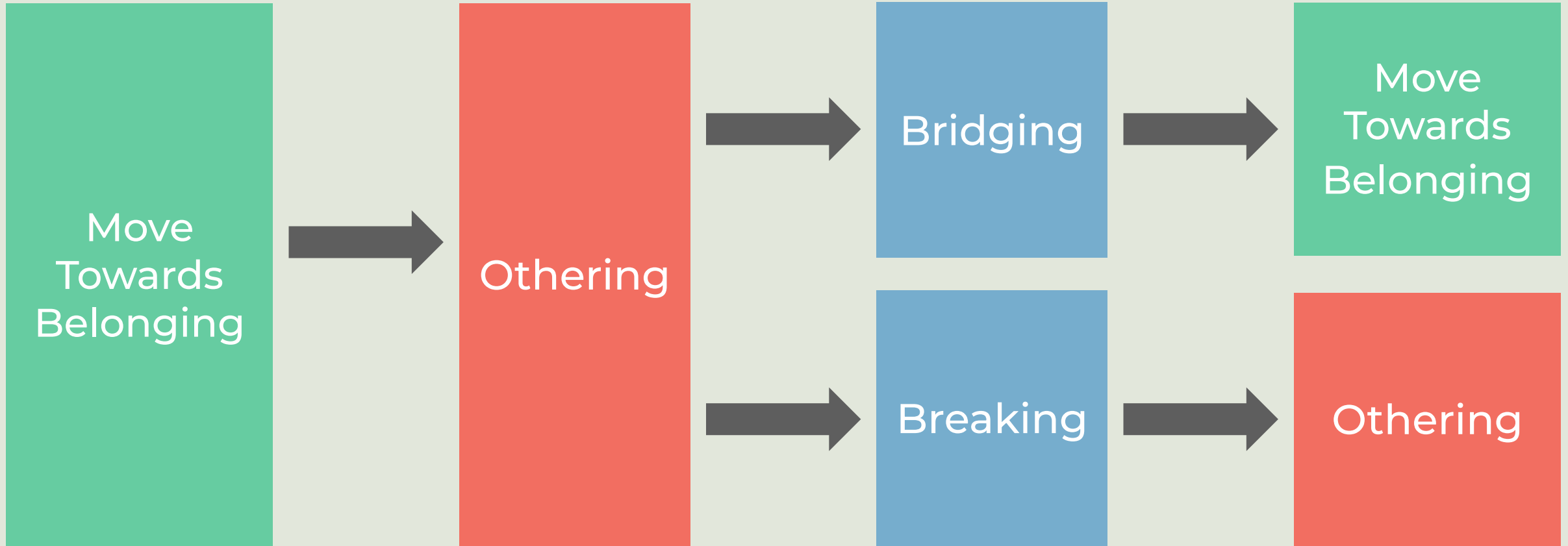
Bridging: Ties to people who are unlike you in some important way; stories, structure contact, willing to listen.

Power Matters

- Bridging may look different where there is a power differential.
- Power is positional, structural, and hierarchal.
- Individuals can build relationships with institutions and individuals who have relative power to access resources.

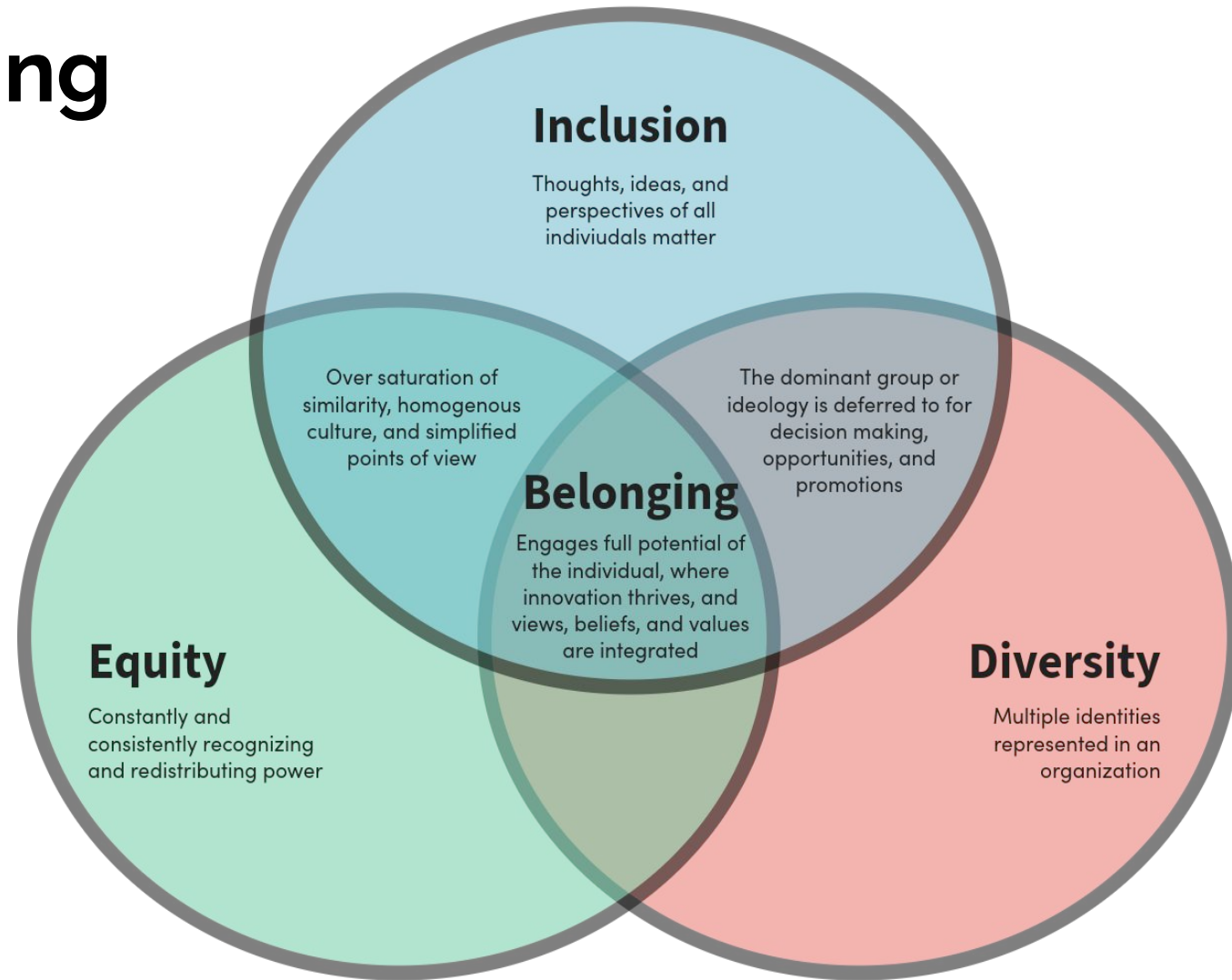

Why move from DEI to Bridging and Belonging?

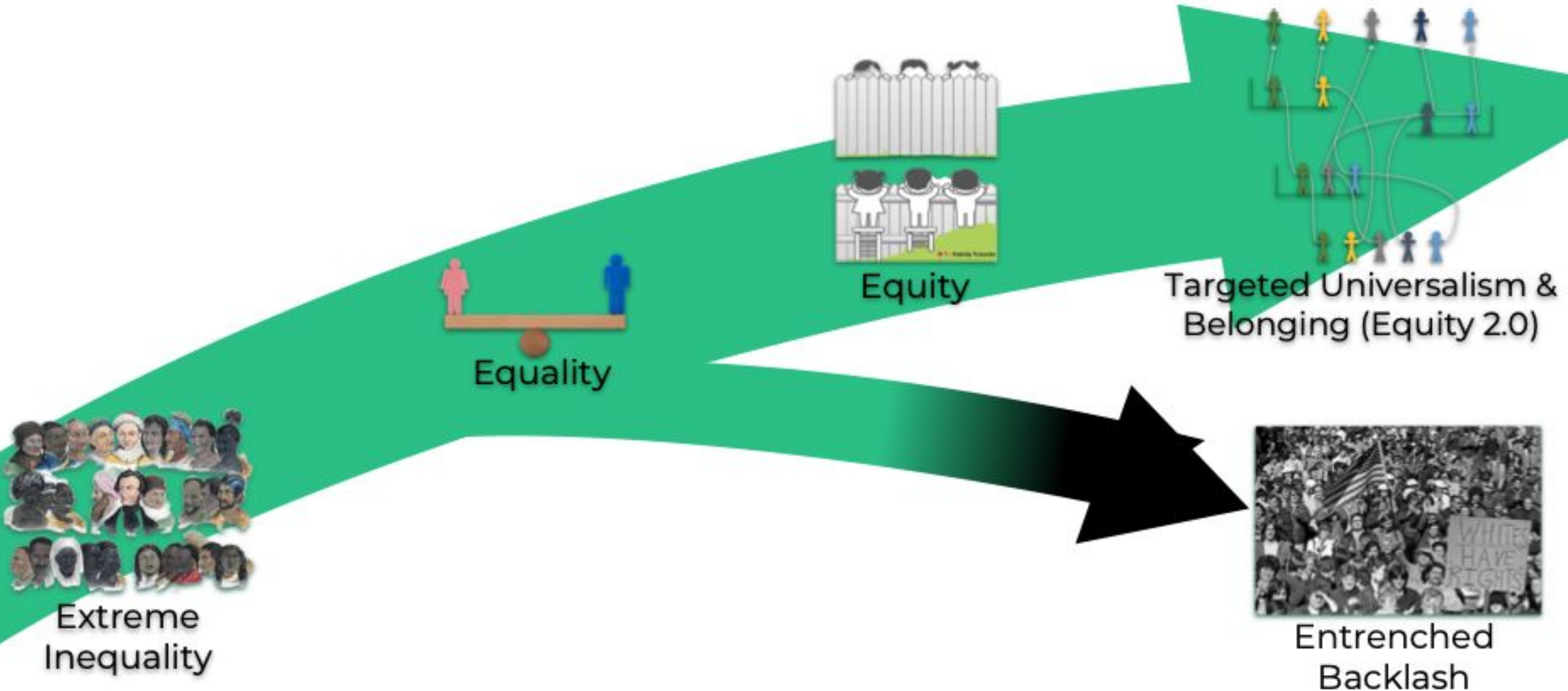
- We don't want to just welcome people into existing structures
- We want people to **co-create structures and institutions**
- The **work of bridging happens through co-creation**

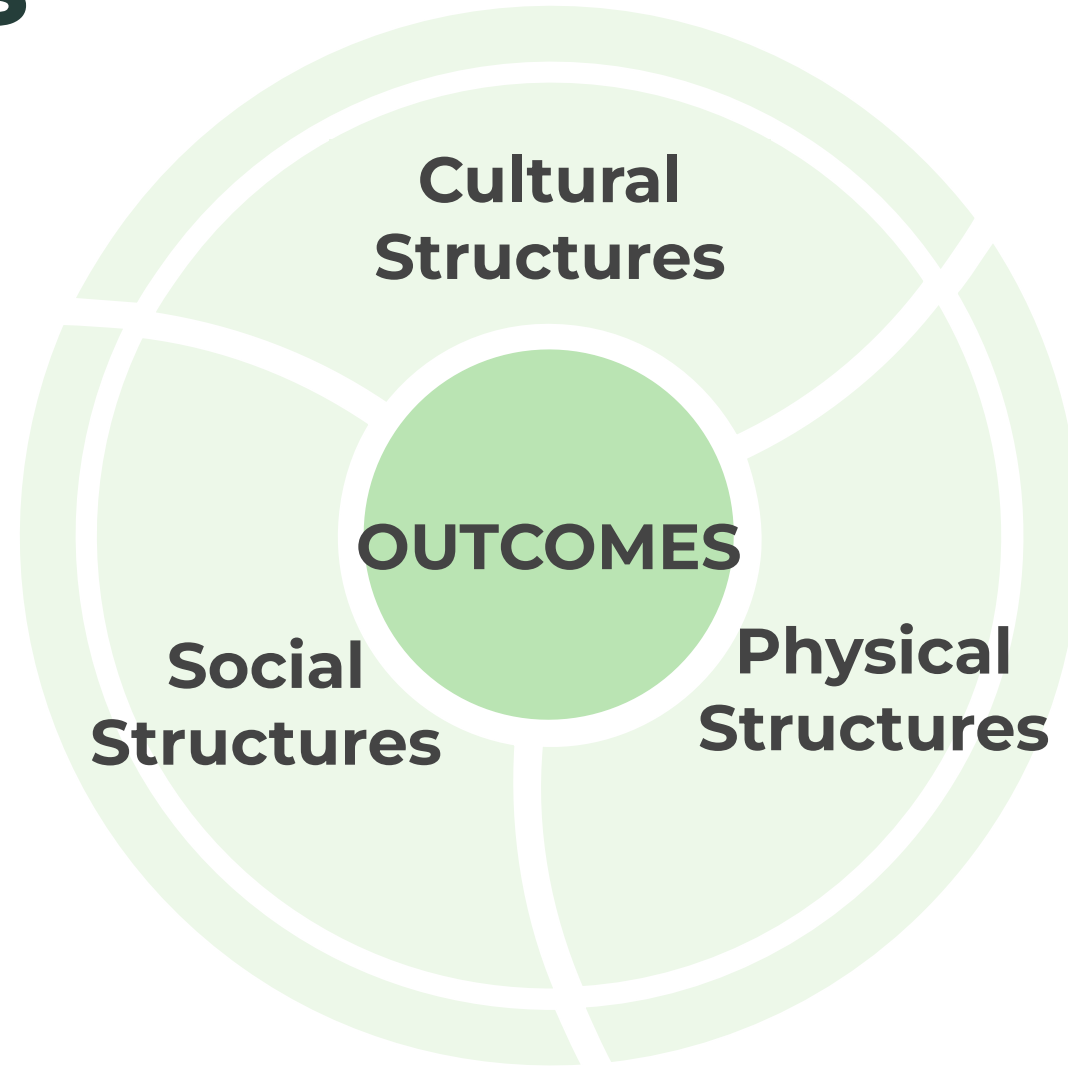

Othering & Belonging within Structures

We are all situated within structures, but not evenly.

These structures are not neutral.



Power gives us greater positive access to structures and more ability to shape structures.

A framework for belonging

	Low Belonging	High Belonging
Uniqueness is Valued	Differentiation <i>I am different</i> <i>I am uncomfortable</i>	Deep Belonging <i>I belong</i> <i>I can be myself</i>
Sameness is Valued	Exclusion <i>I am different</i> <i>I am uncomfortable</i>	Assimilation <i>I can fit in</i> <i>I have to be guarded</i>

Structures do work: power and position matter

People are situated differently with regard to structures and infrastructure.



People also impact these relationships and can change the structure of the system.

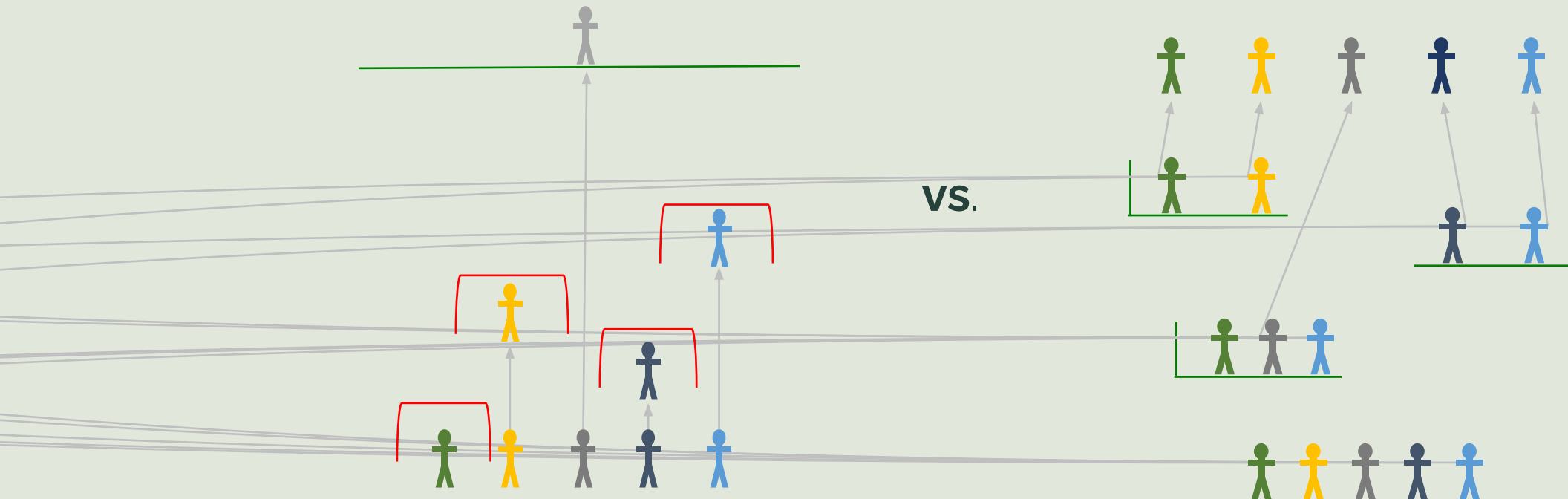
Targeted Universalism

A framework for achieving Equity 2.0

The TU Framework

Structural inequity produces consistently different outcomes for different communities

Targeted universalism responds with universal goals and targeted solutions



Cracked Containers

- When there's a crack in the container—when the context in which we live is broken—everyone feels othered and our solutions need to be more radical.



Create new containers where people are valued and connect

- An opportunity to move beyond polarization and toward **co-creation**
- Structural belonging requires: mutual power, access, and opportunity among all within a shared container (such as a society, organization, etc).



Targeted Universalism as a Method for Co-Creation

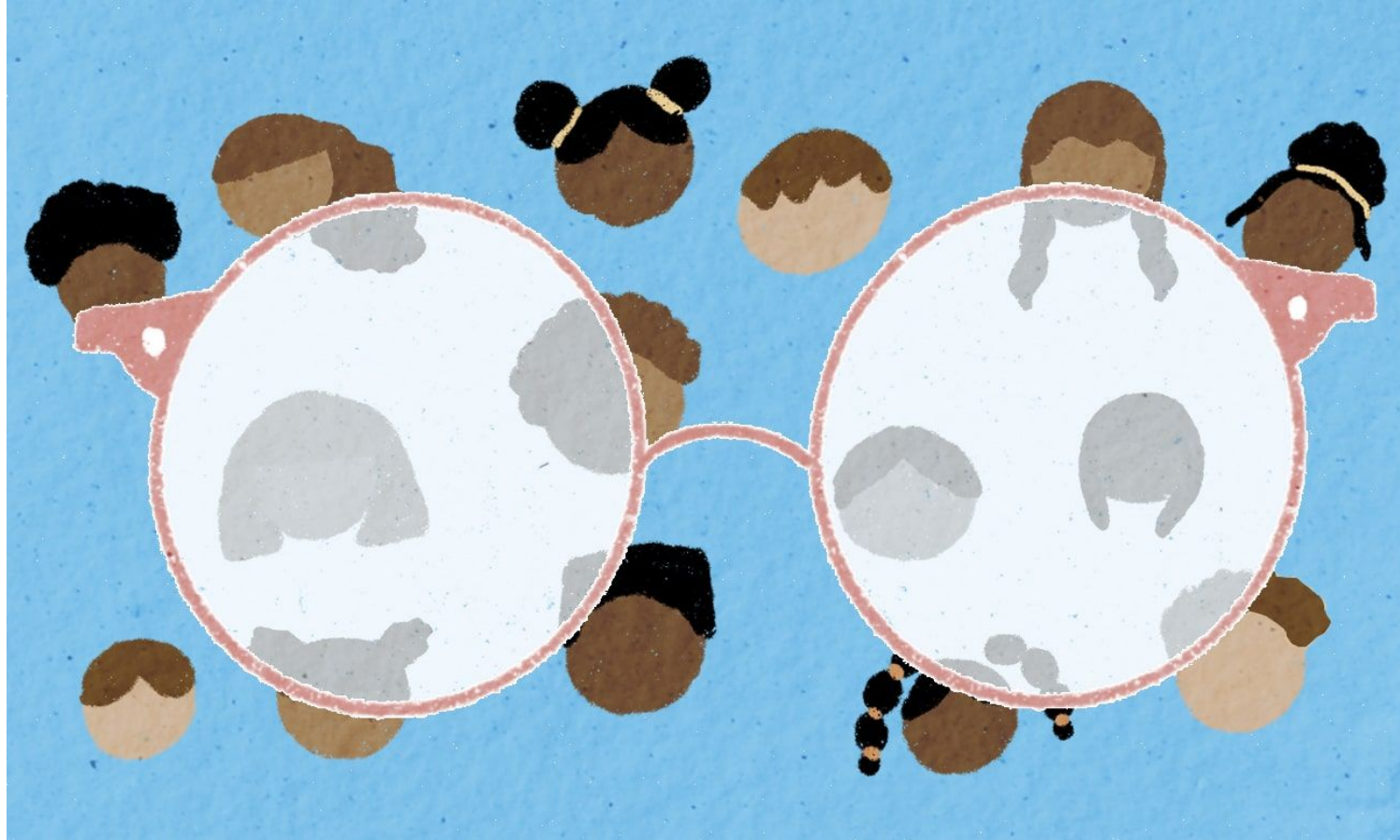

Targeted Universalism Steps

1. Co-create a universal goal
2. Assess the general performance relative to the universal goal
3. Identify groups performing differently with respect to the goal
4. Assess the structures that impede each group from achieving the goal
5. Develop and implement targeted strategies so all groups reach goal
6. Develop bridging messaging and stories that support strategies.

We cannot ignore our differences when identifying how groups perform relative to the universal goal.

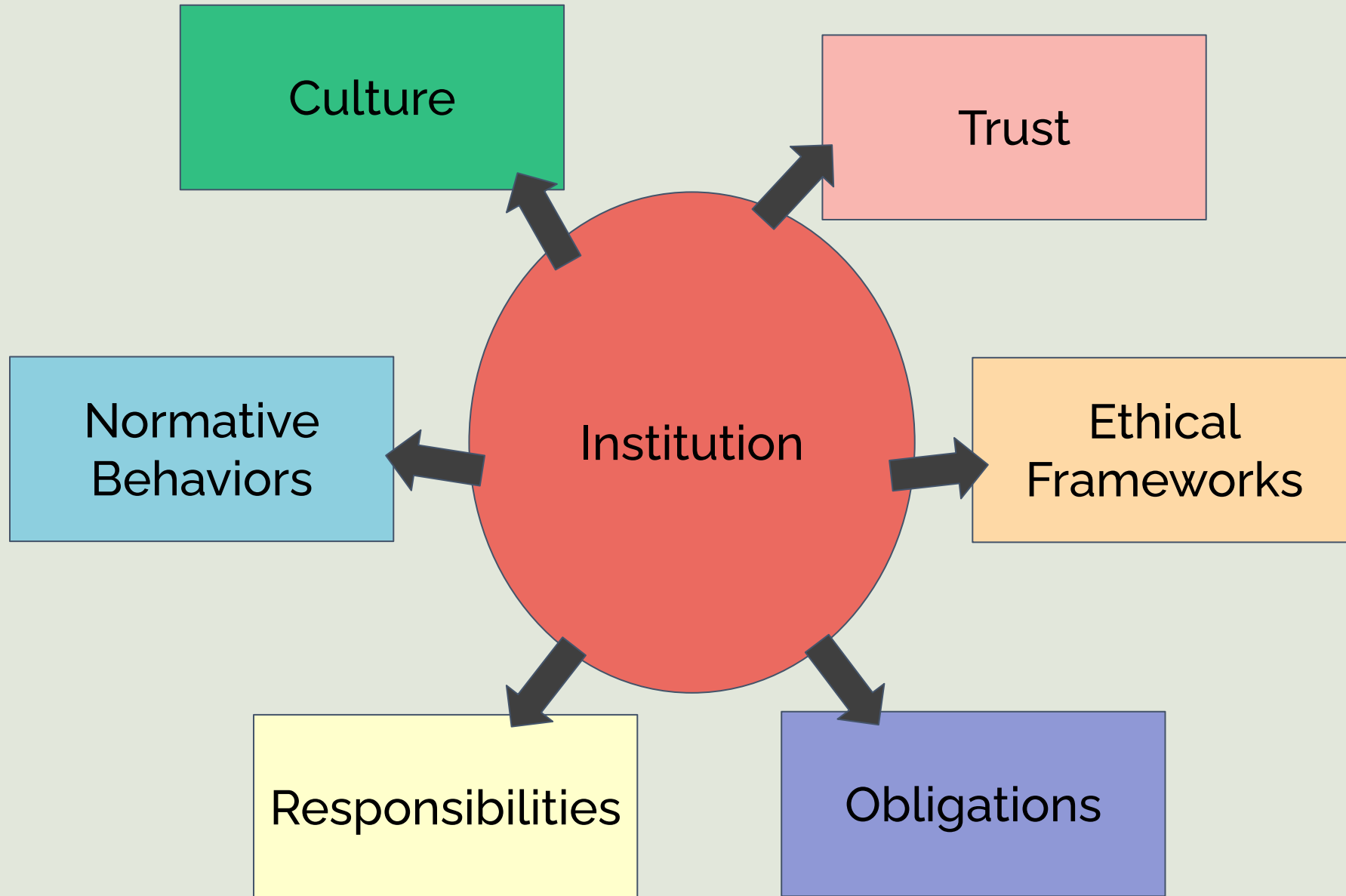

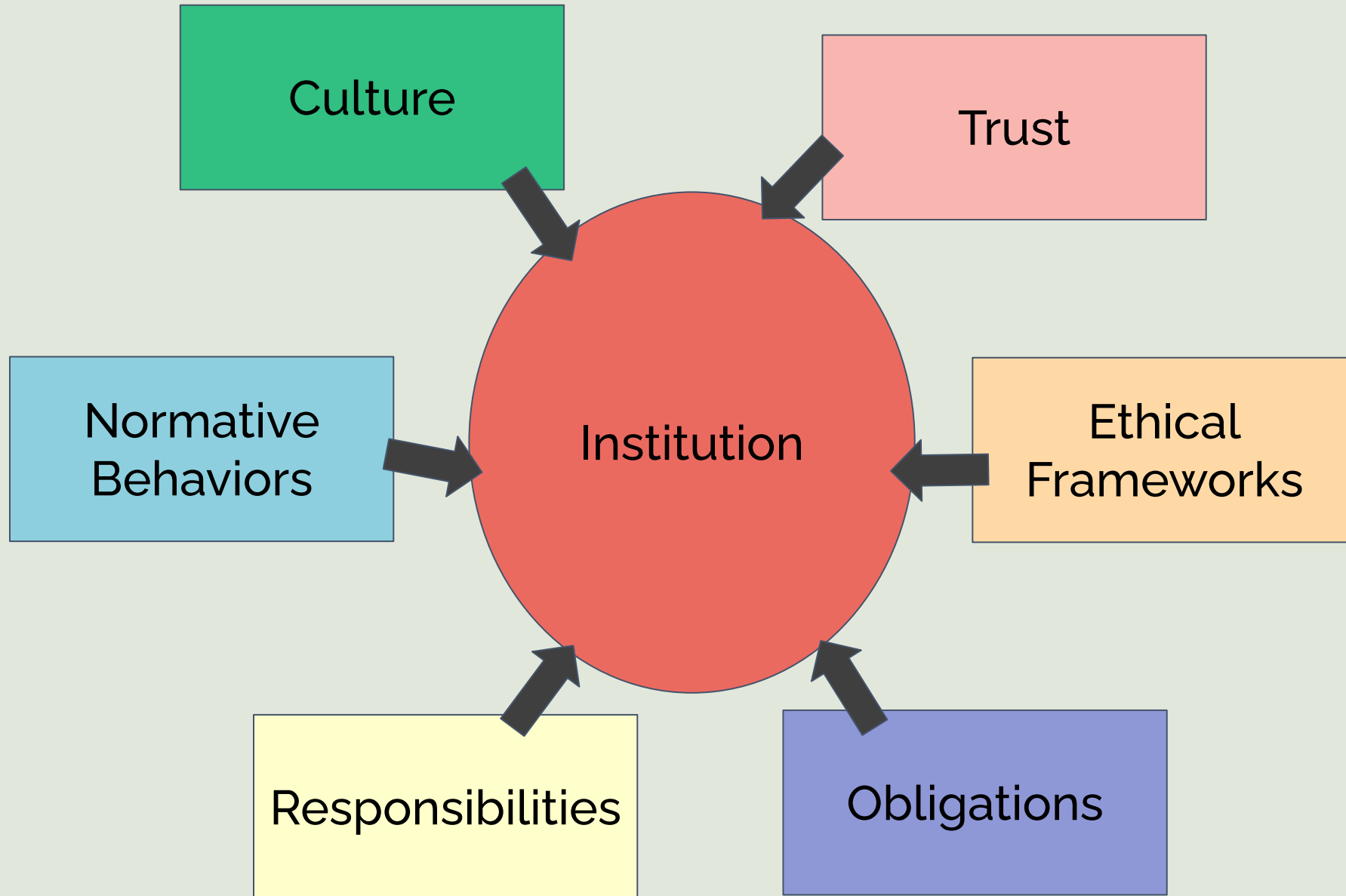

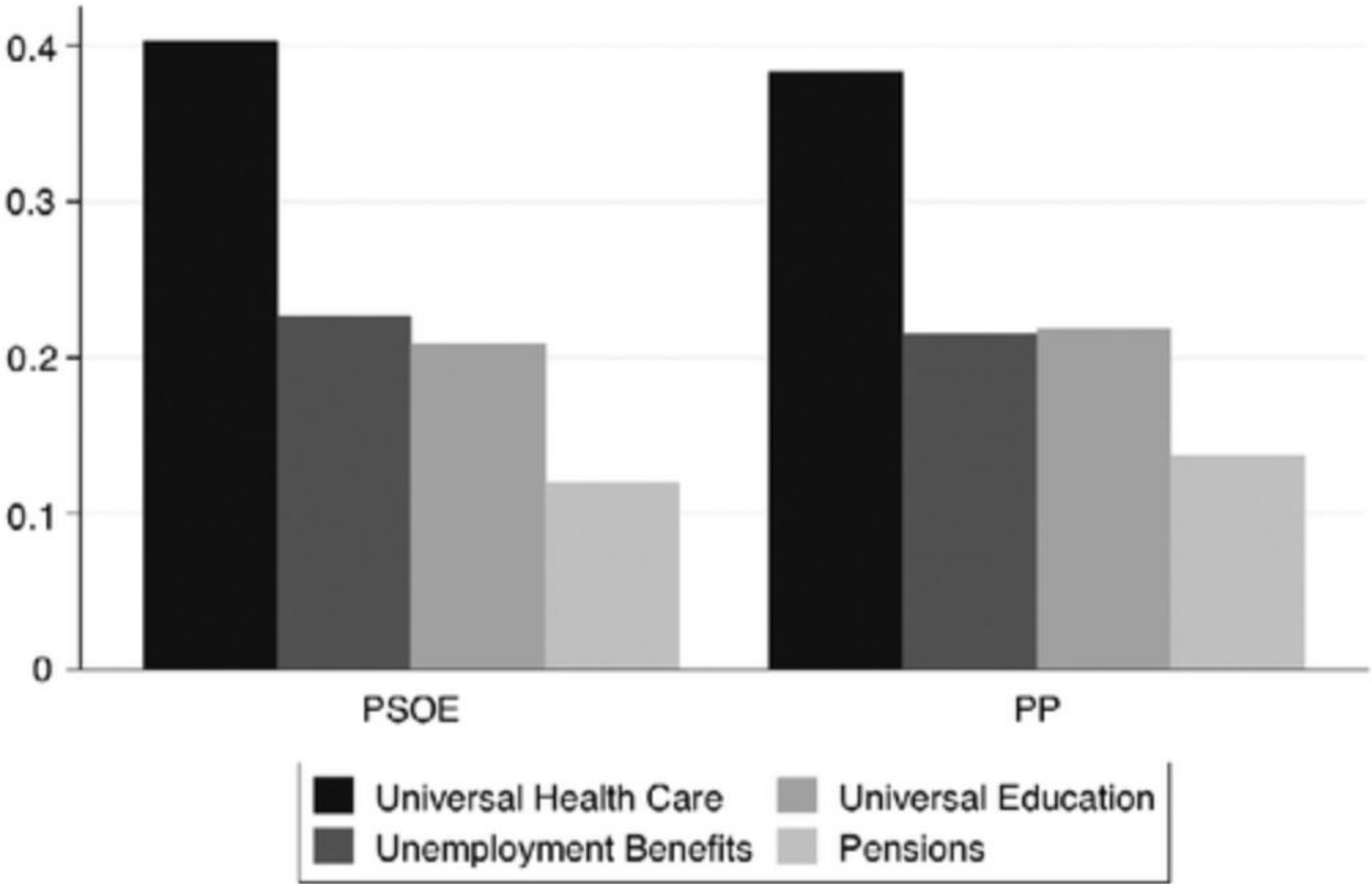

is othered. A new story.**

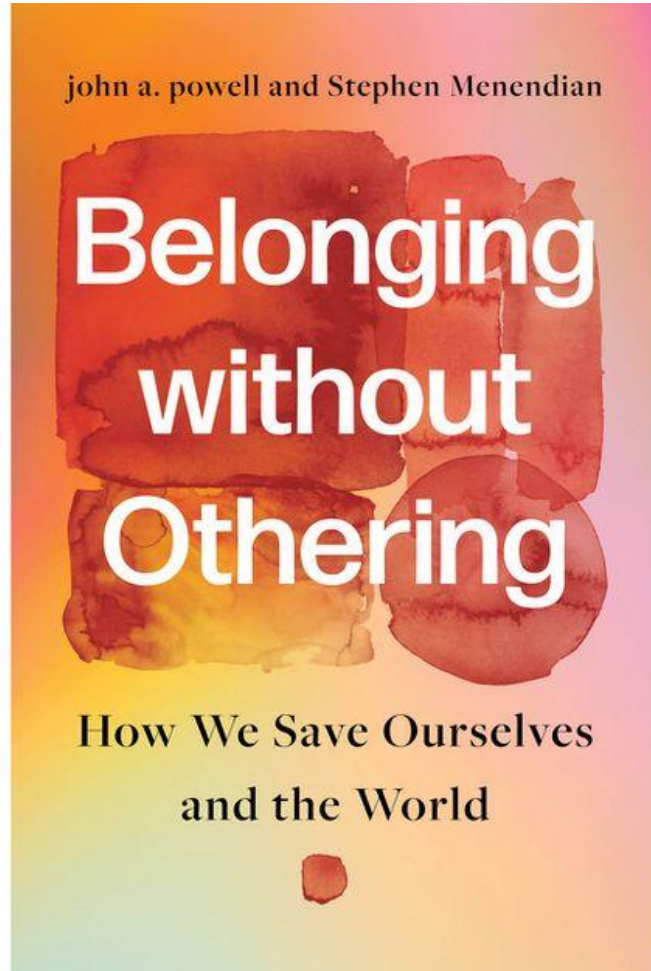

For us, belonging is...

1. Inclusion + equity
2. Visibility and recognition
3. Agency + power
4. Connection

Belonging exists when all social groups are included in critical institutions and in their communities; are accorded visibility within those institutions or communities; have agency, including the ability to participate in shaping those institutions and communities; and when groups report a sense of connection or feeling of belonging. **Belonging is both a feeling and a practice, subjective and objective.**
