Hosted by the Othering & Belonging Institute at UC Berkeley, the Othering & Belonging Conferences are dynamic, uniquely-curated events where we come together to explore the narratives, ideas, and practices we need to build a world based on belonging.

The belonging we are advocating for is foundational and unconditional, it does not have to be earned. It is a belonging that is about more than just having access, it is being able to make demands on the political and economic structures that shape our lives, and to fully participate in co-creating the societies we live in now, and want to leave for future generations.

While a world without othering may seem impossible, the reality is that we are already seeing a global movement for belonging gain momentum, with people and partners all over the world who believe this new world is at least a *possibility*, and that this possibility is one that we can organize around.

The Othering & Belonging Conference is a space where we try to give life to that possibility, and to each other.

Attendees leave with inspiration, shared purpose, and actionable ways forward to building **inclusive**, pluralistic democracies

Sponsorship of the O&B Conference helps support and build a growing, global movement for belonging.

Since our first in 2015, each conference has grown each year in scale and reach, with new partners, participants, and geographies:

- In 2024, we welcomed 2,147 participants in person to Oakland, our highest in-person attendance ever.
- People from 85 countries took part in our 2024 conference via livestream and in-person.
- We hosted our first international conference in Berlin in 2023.
- In 2026 we are hosting our US conference outside of the San Francisco Bay Area for the first time in order to build new relationships and learn from each other across different political, cultural, and historical contexts.
- Financial support allows us to offer scholarships and discounted registrations for those who would otherwise not be able to attend, as well as extend the conference learnings to global audiences via innovative digital technology and platforms

Conference sessions are extended through OBI's innovative, wide-reaching communications which prioritize accessibility and transformative public and political education.



Sessions and talks from our conferences are a major driver to our social media platforms—on <u>OBI's Instagram</u> account, our video reels have been viewed 817,856 times, and counting, a 189.5% increase just since 2023.

OBI's social media platforms have close to 65K followers.

Over 7,000 people tuned into the 2024 conference livestream hosted at OBI University, our free online educational and community hub.

OBI's email list has over 100,000 subscribers O&B 2024 was attended in person or livestream by reporters and editors from 10 major news outlets including The New York Times, LA Times, San Francisco Chronicle, and KQED.
