Overview of survey characteristics

Florida

- Statewide survey of n=1,729 residents
 - 518 White; 703 Latino; 436 Black; 45 AAPI; 27 Other
- Administered online to representative sample of adults, weighted to match Census ACS
- More than 125 questions on race relations, diversity, equity, public policy, role of government

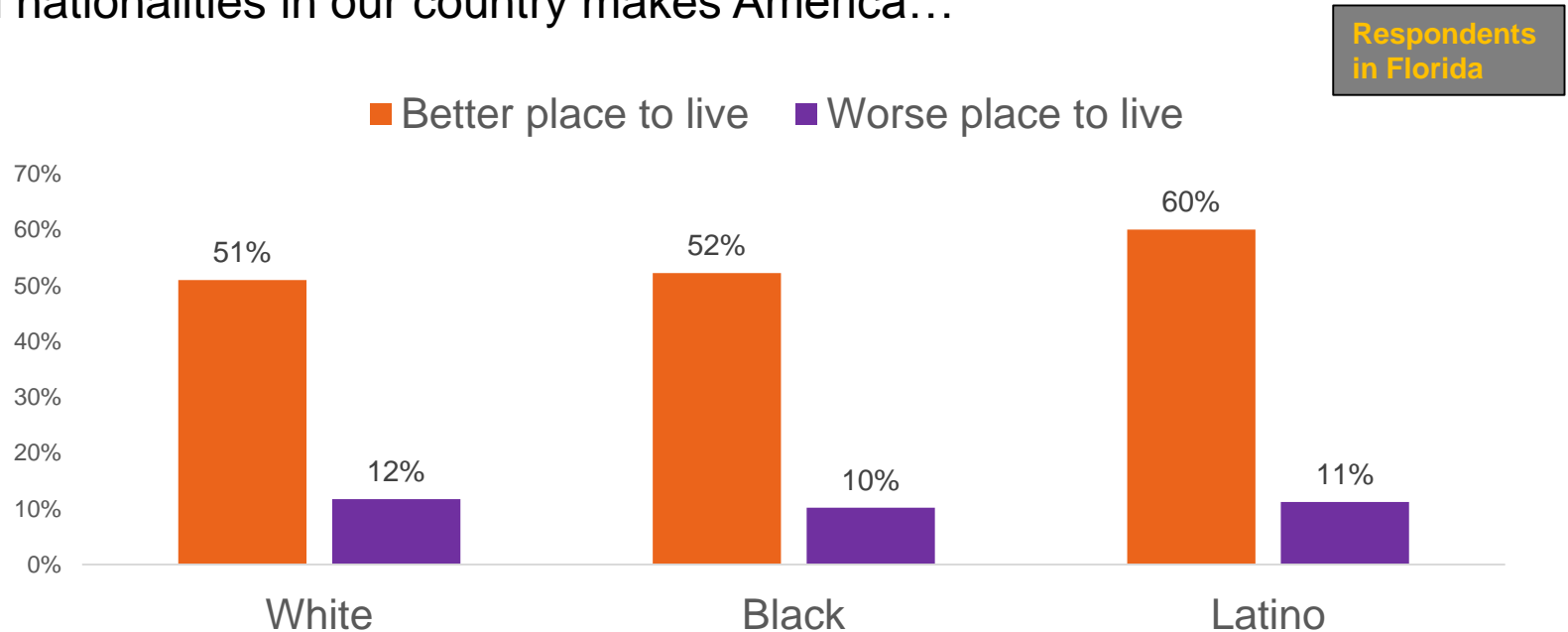

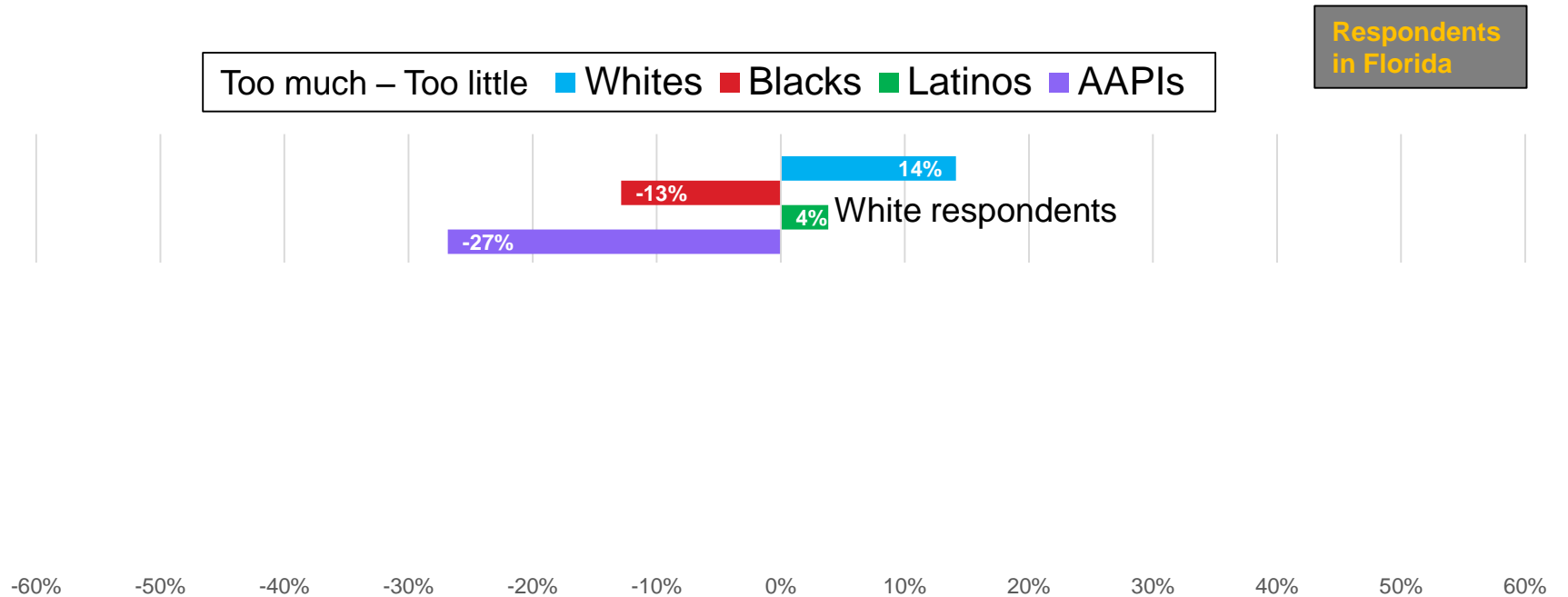
Florida: Value of increasing diversity

Having an increasing number of people of many different races, ethnic groups and nationalities in our country makes America...



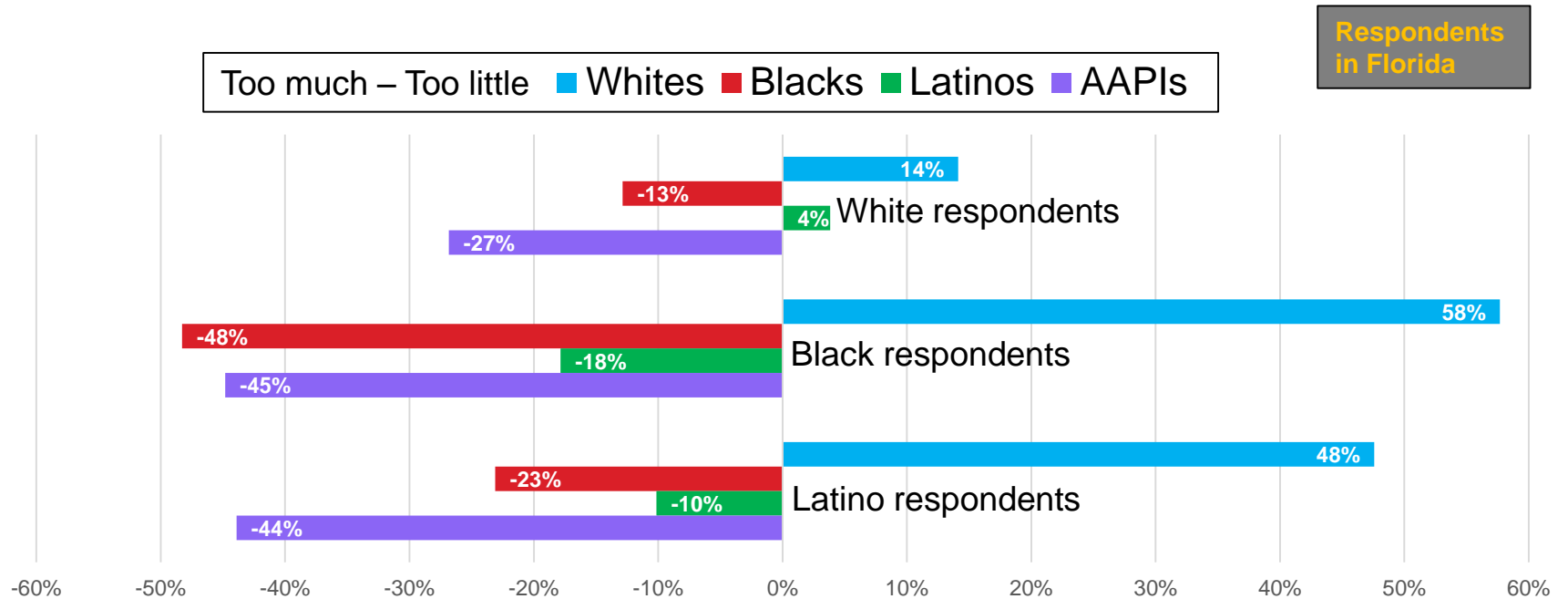
Florida: Too much political influence

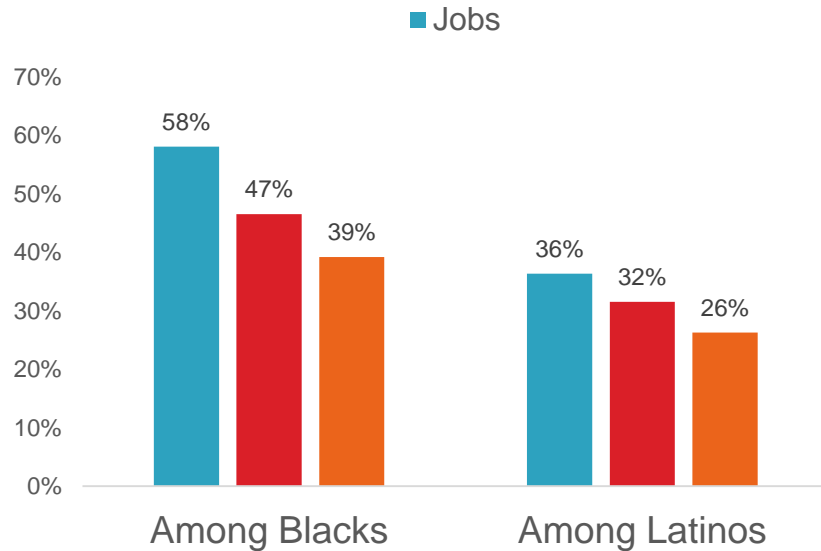

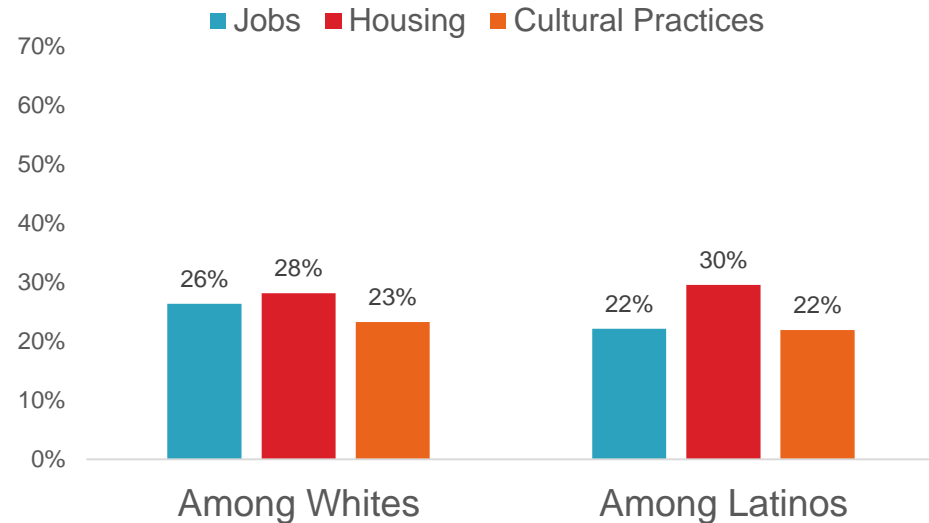

The more that go to Whites, the fewer....

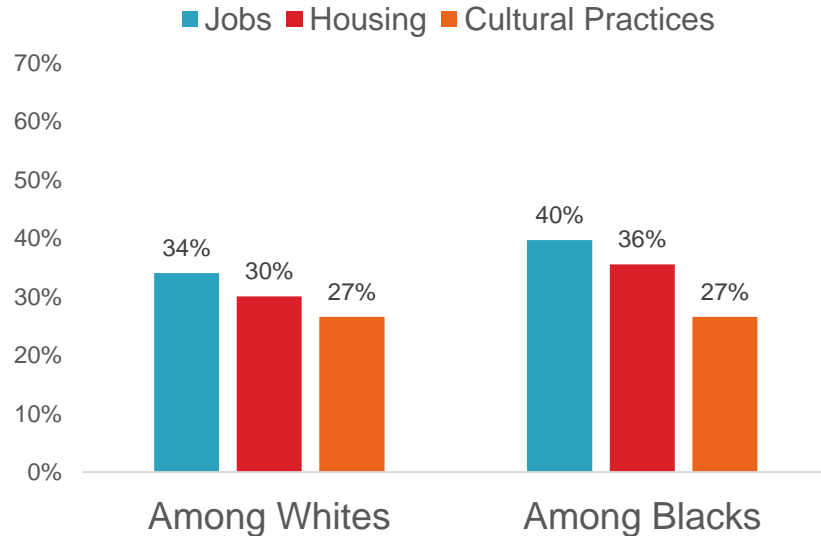


The more that go to Blacks, the fewer....

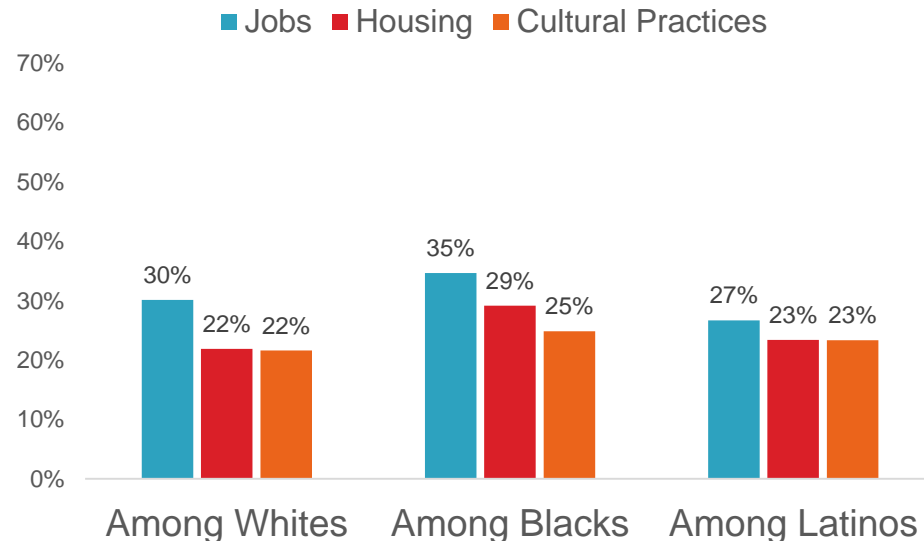

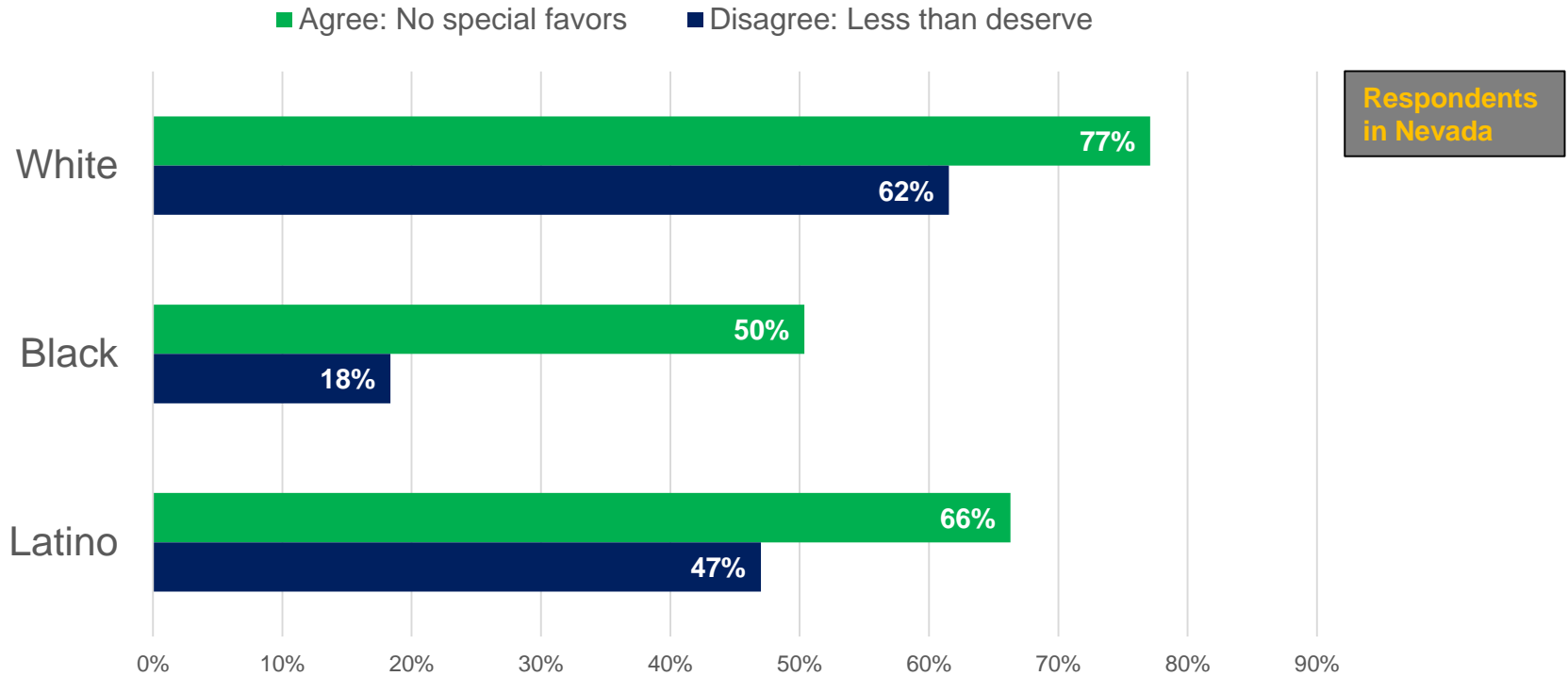
The more that go to Latinos, the fewer....



The more that go to AAPIs, the fewer....

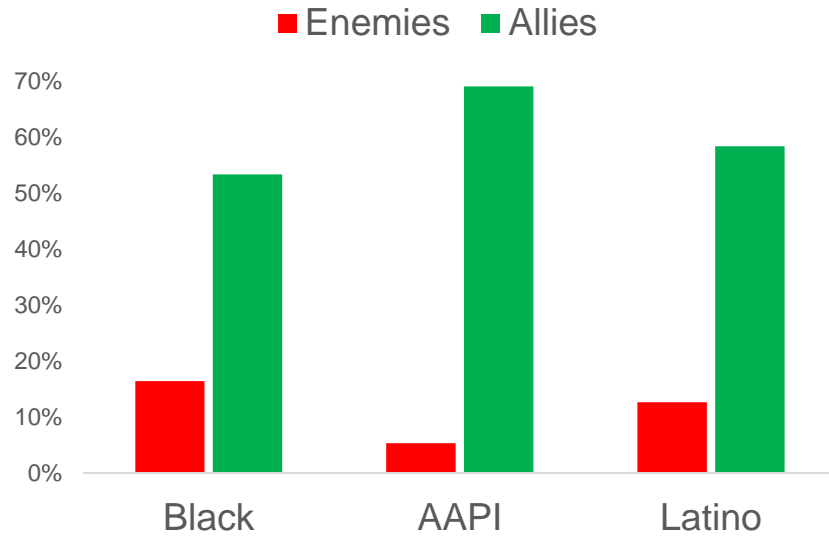

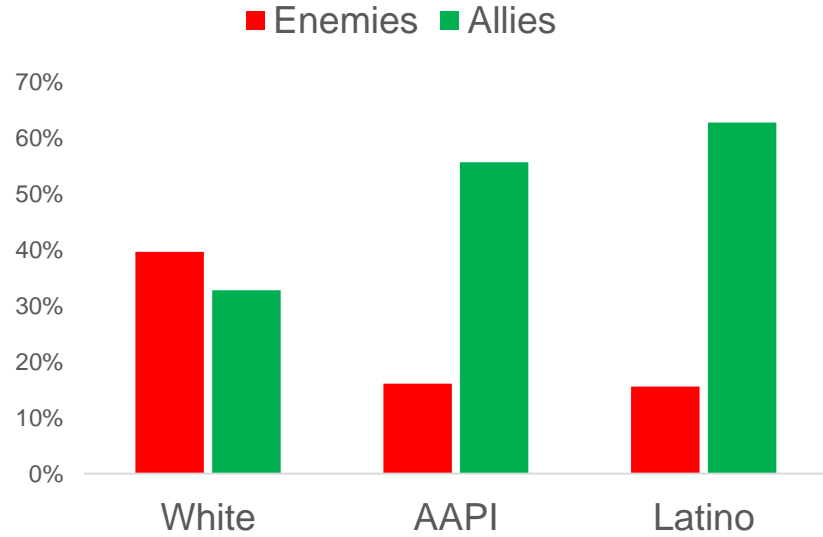

Latino views towards others in FL



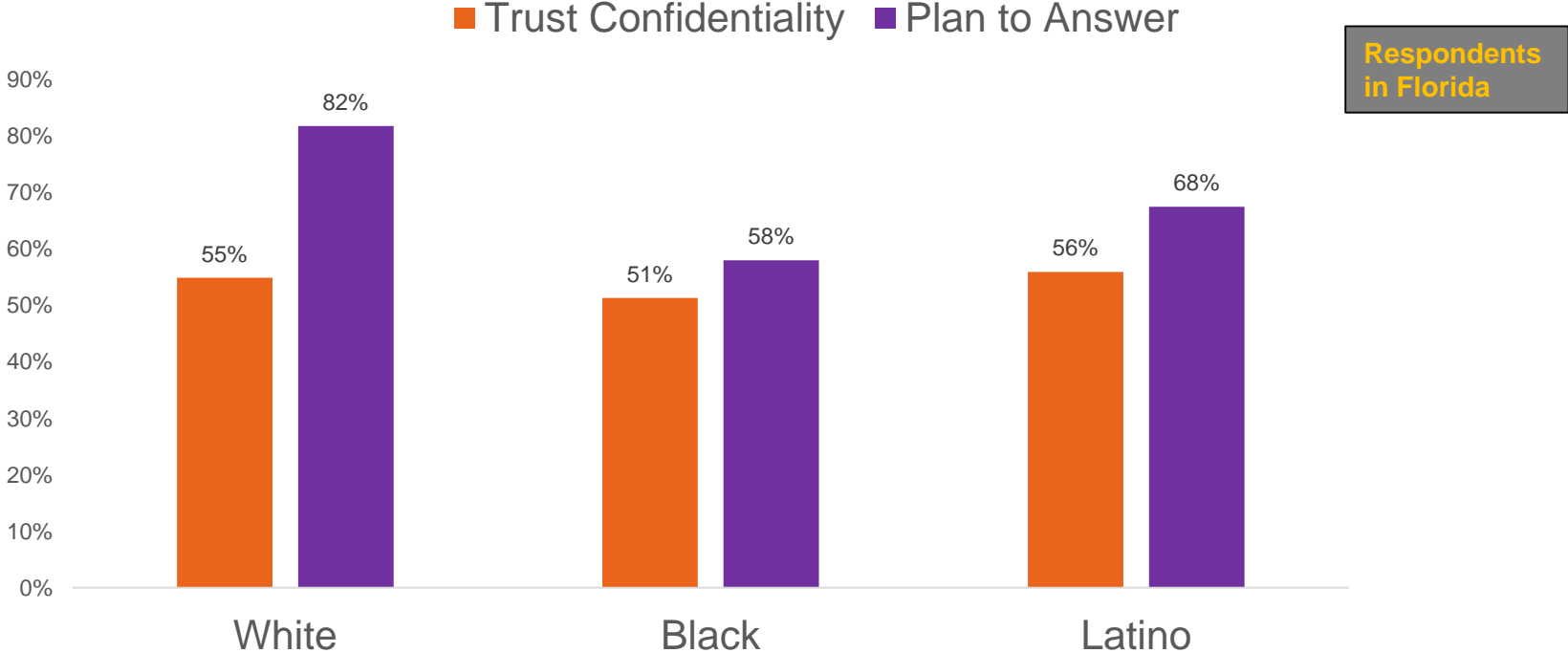

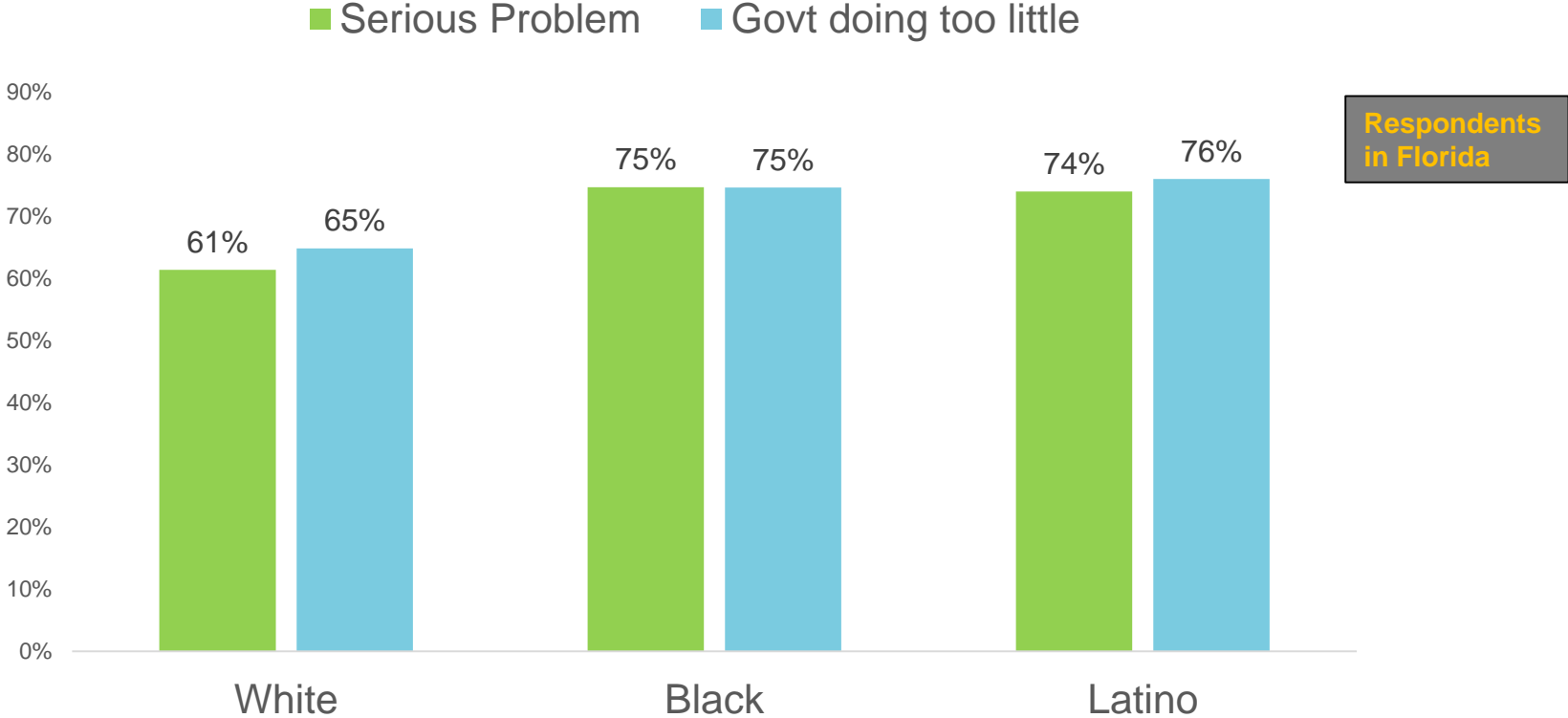

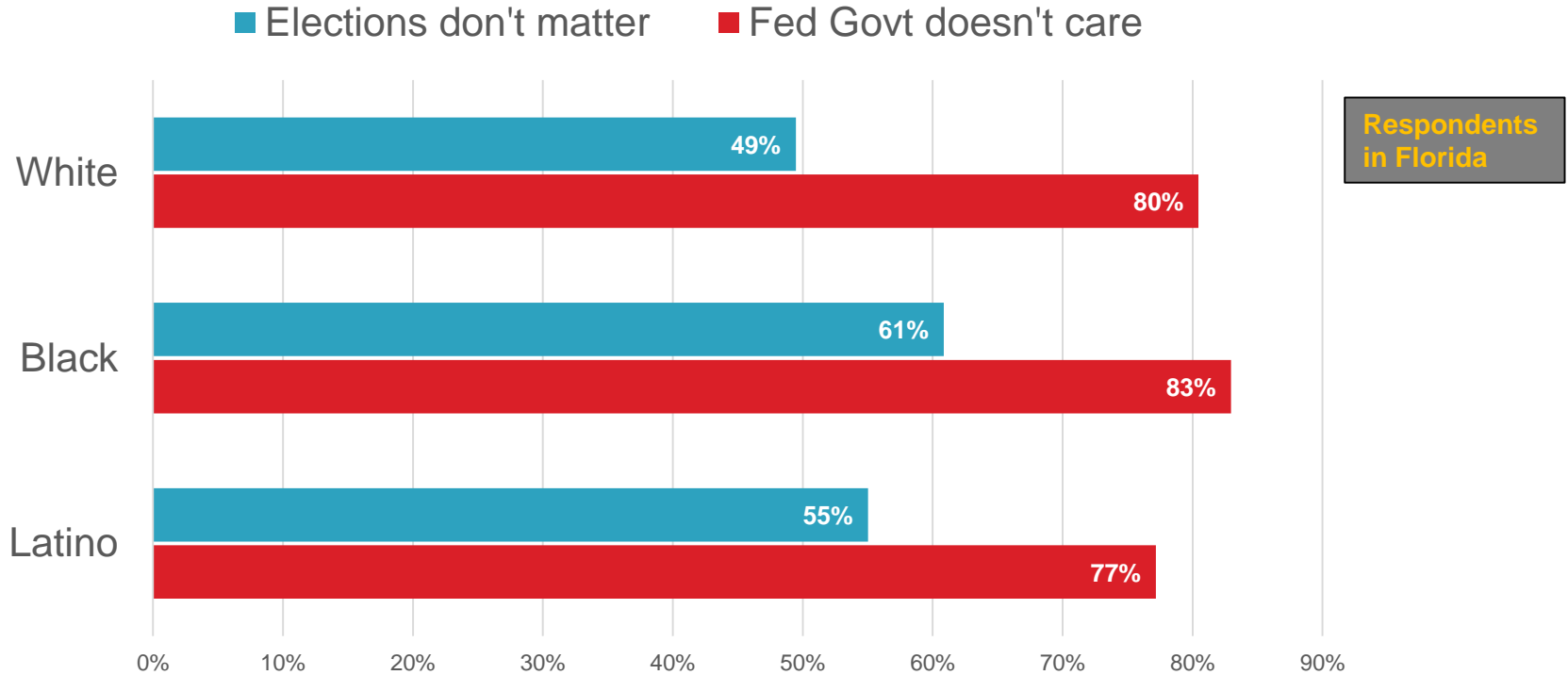

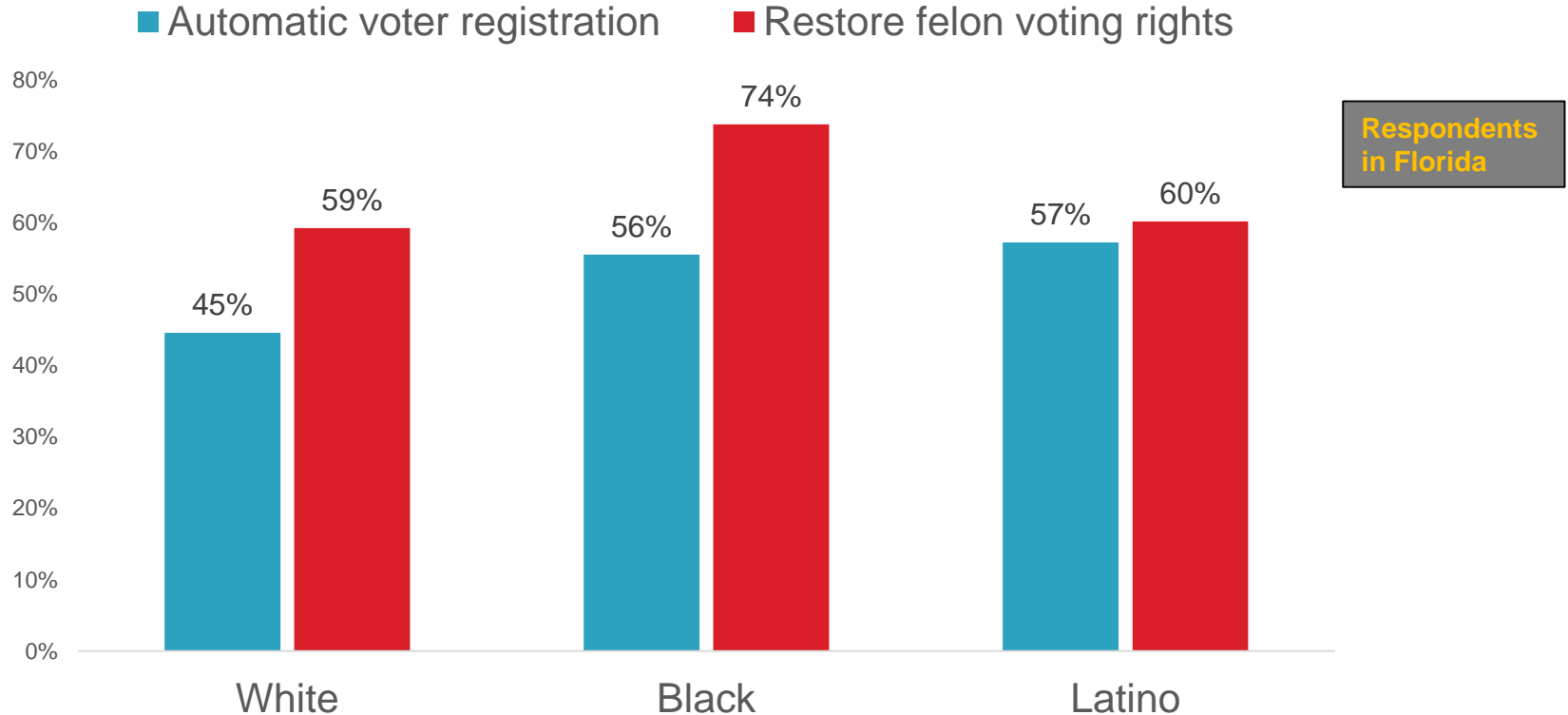

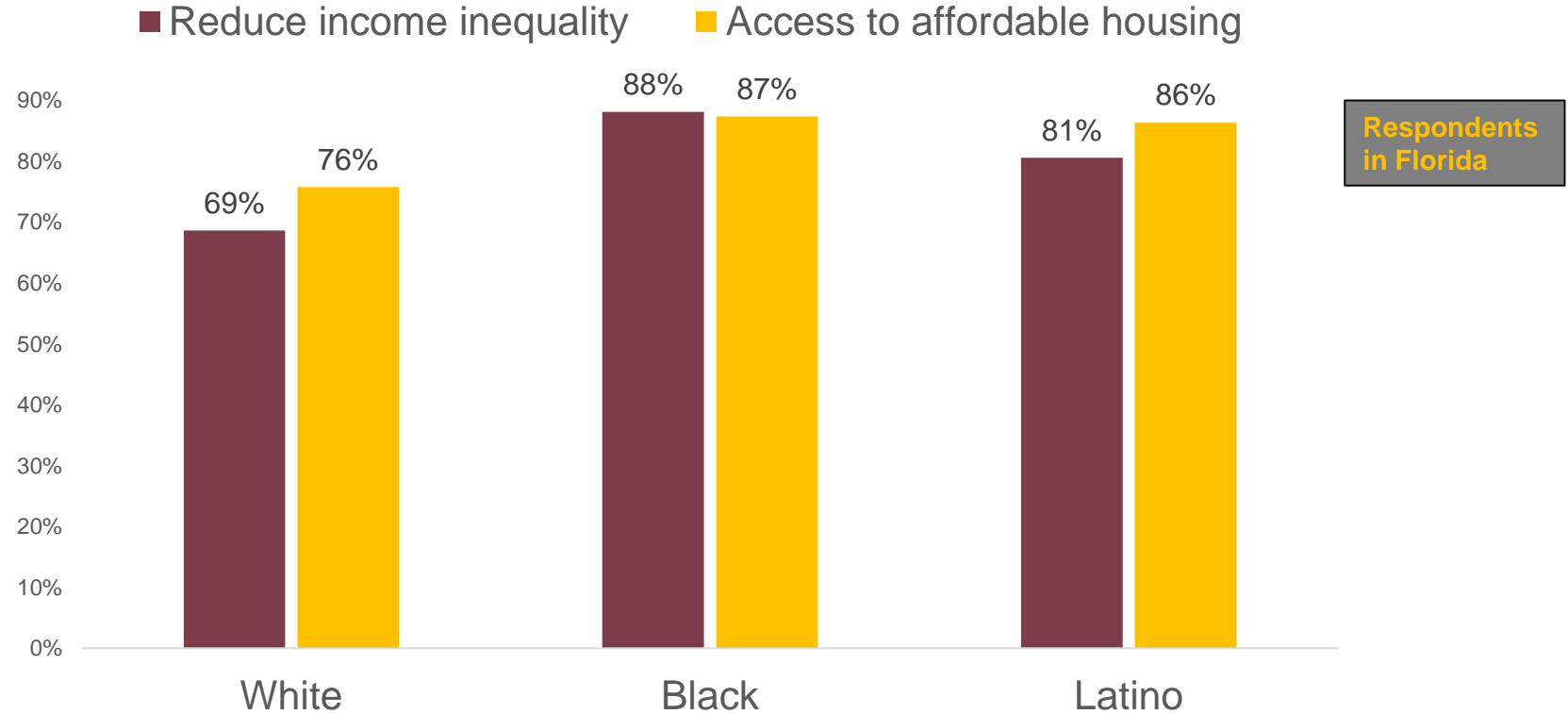

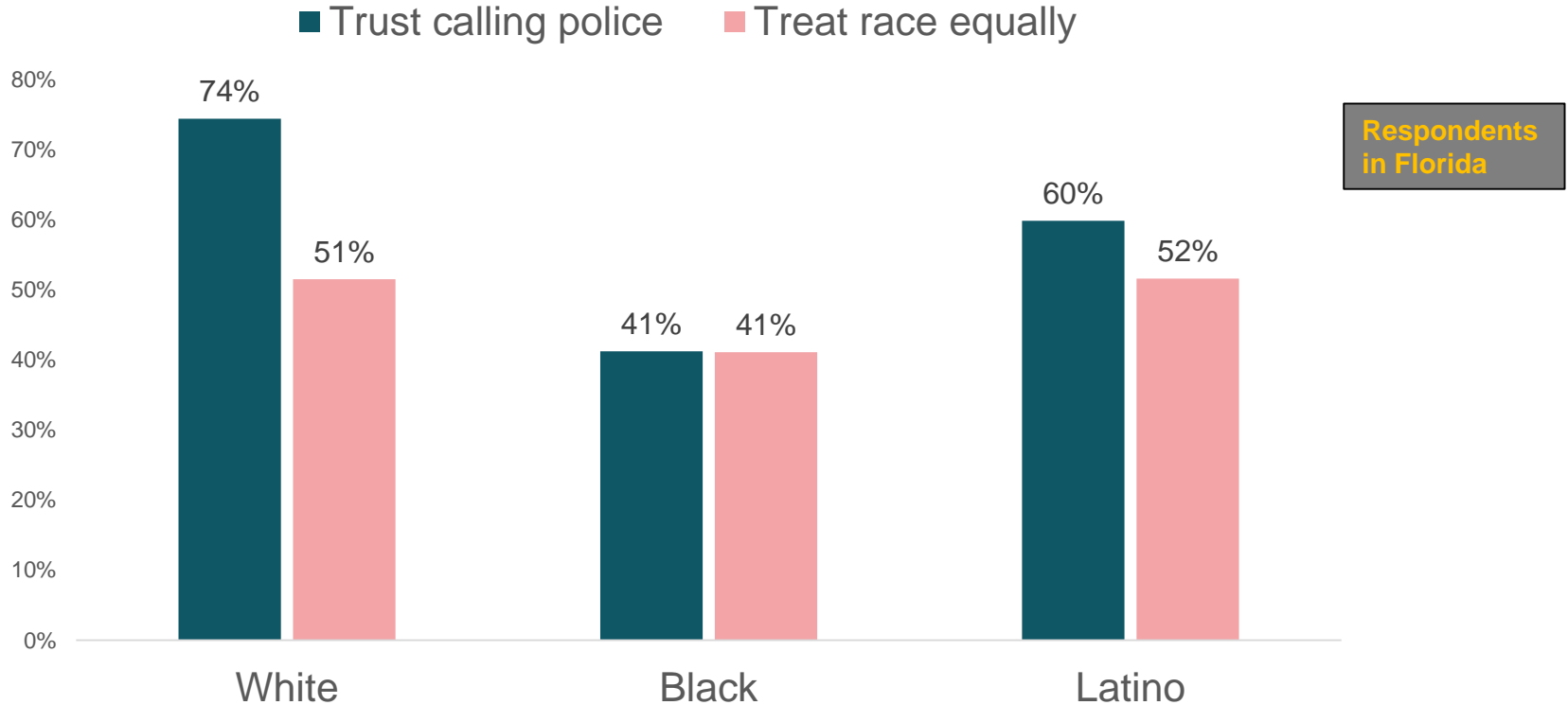

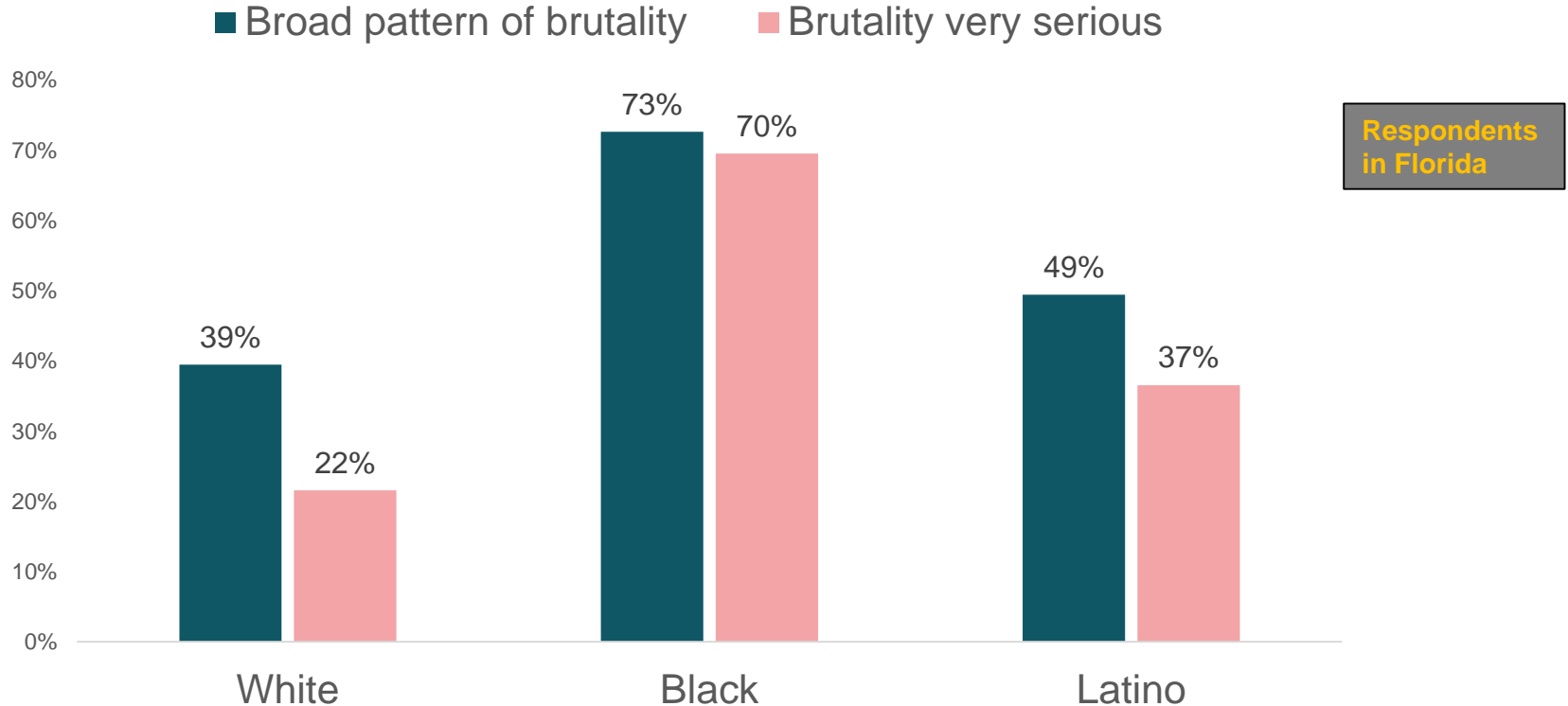

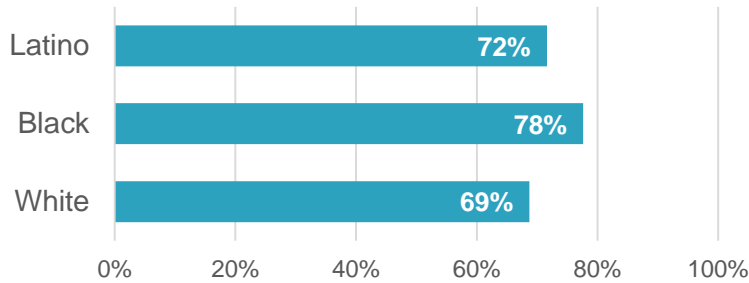

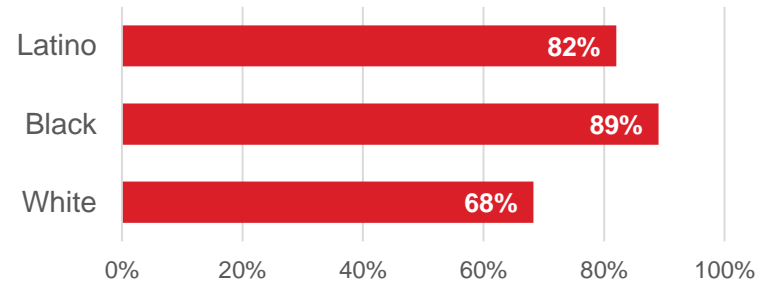

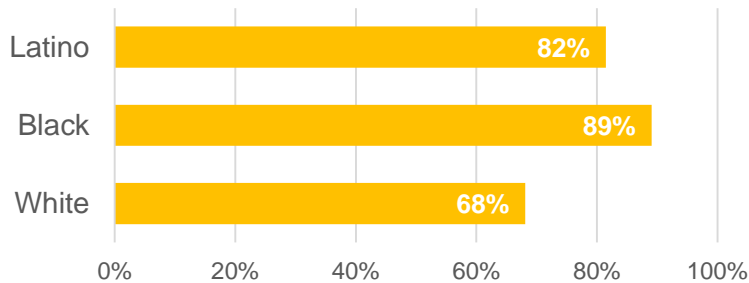

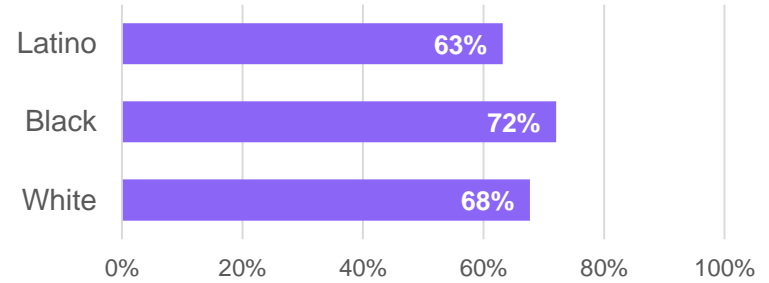
